### **Made in the North East Week - Alnwick Castle**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Made in the North East celebration Alder class will be taking a trip to Alnwick Castle on Friday 28th March. This will tie in nicely with our recent studies on castles.

On the day of the trip, children will depart at 9am from Belsay to travel by coach to Lillidorei where they can enjoy some time exploring the world's largest play structure. We will follow this by exploring the Alnwick Castle grounds. After a lunch break the children will enjoy a castle workshop hosted by the castle team before departing at 3:15pm. Due to our later departure children will need to be collected at the later time of 4pm from Belsay, no school transport will be available for those who usually get a bus/taxi.

We have tried to keep this trip as cost effective as possible and are kindly requesting a voluntary donation towards the cost of transport and admission to the castle of £17.00, per child to be paid via SchoolGateway.
